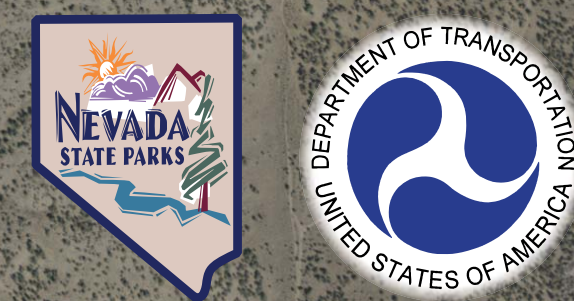
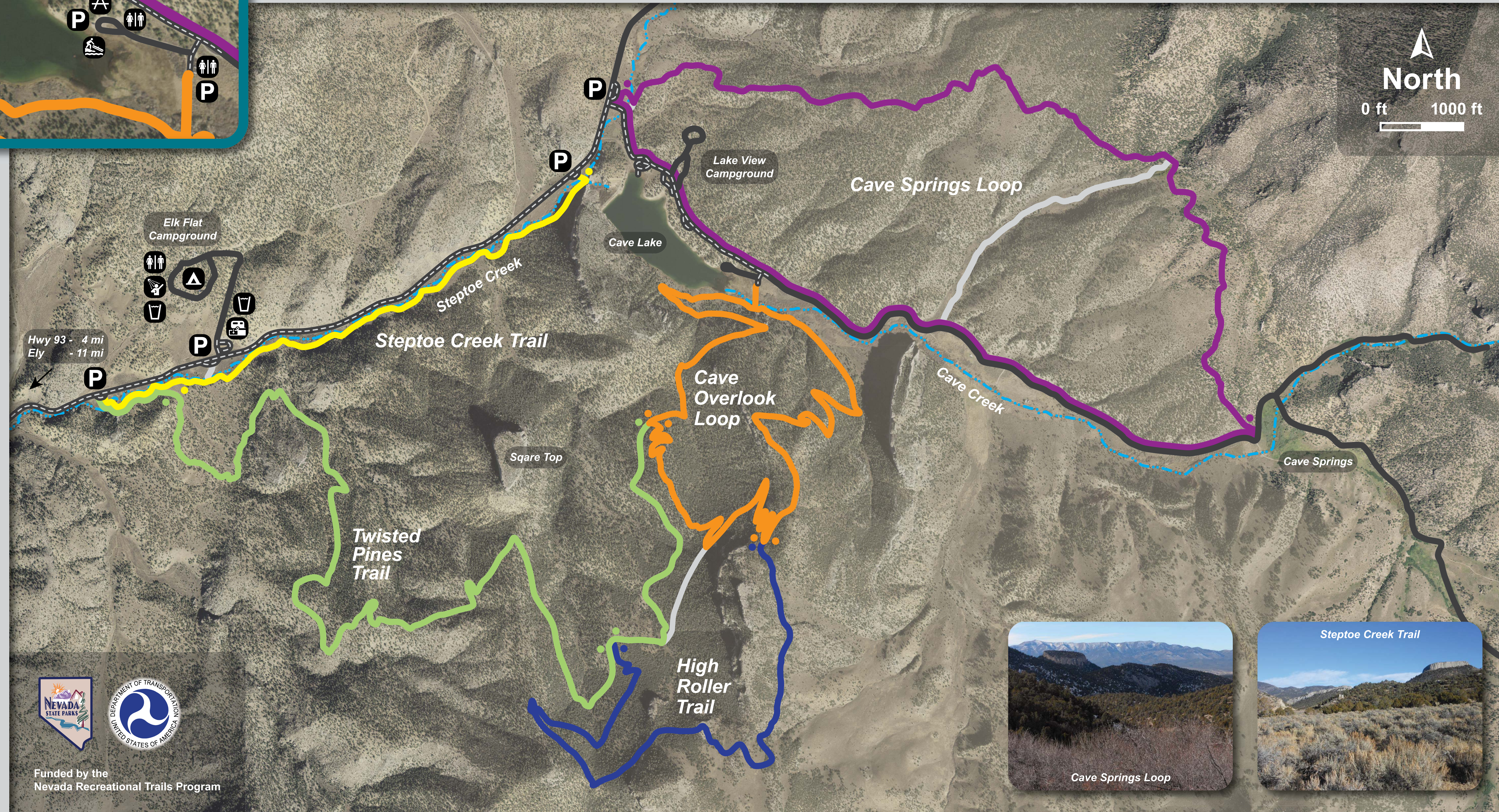


Cave Lake Area Detail
