- **At\_a\_I:** This is an ancient spear-throwing tool that came before the bow and arrow.
- **C\_o\_\_a:** This is a cactus that grows in Valley of Fire it is covered in long spines and is sometimes called the "jumping c\_o\_a."
- **\_oj\_\_e:** This is the name of the desert that Valley of Fire is located in.
- **S\_n\_s\_ on\_:** The red rock formations in Valley of Fire are this type of stone (which is also Nevada's State Rock!)
- **\_ro\_\_on:** This is the name for the natural process of wind and water carving away at rock formations.
- **D\_s\_t V\_rn\_h:** This is the name of the black coating that forms on the surface of Valley of Fire's red rock formations in some areas.
- **P\_t\_g\_ph:** These are symbols and images that were carved and chipped into rocks by Native Americans hundreds to thousands of years ago.
- **P\_t\_if\_e\_ L\_g:** This is the name of wood that has turned into stone due to a natural process.
- **\_ir\_ W\_\_\_:** This is one of Valley of Fire's most famous rock formations it is shown on the cover of the park brochure.
- **Cre\_so\_\_:** This shrub has long branches with small green leaves, and is one of the most common plants in Valley of Fire. Native Americans had a wide variety of uses for this plant.
