Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan

- Mineral County Report

Every five years, the Nevada Division of State Parks (NDSP) leads the development of the Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP), a research-based plan that evaluates the supply and demand of outdoor recreation resources and facilities across all jurisdictions. Specifically, the SCORP identifies outdoor recreation needs and opportunities for recreation improvements and development, provides the foundation for the distribution of Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) monies for outdoor recreation and open space acquisition, and outlines the overall status of outdoor recreation in Nevada.

The 2022-2026 Nevada SCORP was developed over a 12-month period and represents a collaboration between NDSP and the Nevada Division of Outdoor Recreation (NDOR). The following pages provide valuable information that was gained through two public surveys. The data summary includes all 6,072 initial public survey responses and 720 responses to the Part 2: How and Where We Recreate survey. The report further segments the survey respondent data from the eleven frontier counties and provides highlights for the Nye County-specific data set.

This report is intended to assist land management agencies with applications for LWCF funds through the Open Project Selection Process (OPSP). We also hope that this profile will be utilized by legislators, county commissioners, planning commissions, city councils, travel and tourism offices, non-profits, and Parks and Recreation departments to assist with outdoor recreation planning, funding and advocacy.









How much of a priority do you feel each of the following types of recreation areas should be for future investment where you live? (essential + high priority)




Where would you like to see the biggest focus of recreation resources in NV? (#1 priority)




What level of priority do you personally place on allocating funding for parks, trails, open space and outdoor recreation facilities in NV?

DEMOGRPAHICS

Highlights of "typical" survey respondents (most frequent answers) based on SCORP public survey demographic questions:

- AGE GROUP:
 - Of all survey respondents, 40% were 45 to 64-years. Frontier county respondents, 39% were 45 to 64-years.
- GENDER:
 - Of all survey respondents, 52% were male. Frontier county respondents tied 50% male/female.
- RACIAL/ETHNIC BACKGROUND:
 - Of all survey respondents, 87% were white, non-Hispanic/Latino. Frontier respondents were 89% white, non-Hispanic/Latino.
- LEVEL OF ACTIVITY:
 - Of all respondents, 53% were moderately active. Frontier county respondents, 57% are moderately active.
- EDUCATION:
 - Of all respondents, 34% have a bachelor's degree. Frontier county respondents, 29% have bachelor's degrees.
- YEARS IN NEVADA:
 - Of all survey respondents, 26% have lived in Nevada 21–35 years. 24% of Frontier county respondents have lived in Nevada 21–35 years.
- HOUSEHOLD ANNUAL INCOME:
 - 25% of all survey respondents cited household annual income between \$100,000 \$149,000. Frontier county respondents, 24% cited household annual income between \$80,000 and \$99,999 per year.




