SEASONAL LIFEGUARD II/HEAD LIFEGUARD (01.918)

Description:

Under the general direction of higher-level Park staff the seasonal Lifeguard II/Head Lifeguard manages the operation of the Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park beach. The Head Lifeguard trains, supervises, and evaluates the performance of assigned personnel, prepares and reviews incident reports, collects data and maintains related records. The incumbent also maintains visitor safety on assigned beach and waterfront areas, responds to emergency and rescue situations, provides visitor services, patrols beaches on foot to observe behaviors and reports unsafe practices and hazards, and maintains a clean waterfront area. The Head Lifeguard utilizes lifesaving techniques, equipment, and watercraft, administers first aid and/or CPR, gives directions and information, explains and enforces park rules and regulations, resolves disputes between park visitors and refers visitors to appropriate sources of information. The incumbent participates in training sessions, practices rescue techniques and lifesaving skills, refines water safety techniques, and maintains watercraft and emergency medical and rescue equipment. Supervises and/or participates in waterfront maintenance, picks up trash and uses hand tools to groom the beach and reports clean-up problems.

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certification issued by the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health, National Registry of Emergency Technicians, or out-of-state equivalent may be substituted for six months experience.

Special Requirement:

Candidates must successfully pass a physical agility test.

Candidates must possess and maintain a current Red Cross Lifeguarding Certificate at the time of appointment and for continuing employment.
