Job Description

The ideal candidate will have a background and interest in planning and/or landscape architecture.

This is a temporary full-time position designed to provide valuable hands-on experience to college students and recent graduates. The position is funded for three months from the date of hire (\$2,000/month stipend).

The intern will work collaboratively with Nevada State Parks staff on park improvement projects across the state. Throughout the summer the intern will apply academic learning to real-world situations and cultivate project management, planning, problem-solving, and communication skills. Duties will include project planning and management, collection and preparation of data, preparation of designs, sketches and renderings of variable complexity, site investigation, research of funding sources, writing grant proposals and other assignments as directed.

Job Requirements

- Current enrollment in a university or community college, or recent college graduate, with a focus on planning and/or landscape architecture.
- Ability to work and communicate successfully in a team environment.
- Knowledge and experience with CAD is desirable but not required.
- Travel throughout the state to conduct site visits will be required.
- Applicants must be capable of hiking/walking long distances in rugged terrain and adverse conditions.
- A valid driver's license is required at the time of appointment.
- At least 50% of the time will be spent working in Carson City. Camping arrangements may be available for students from outside the Carson City Area.
