







BI-01	SST Restroom \$17,000		Day Use Area currently has only a portable toilet. No septic is required.
BI-02	GPS \$250		Help staff create trail maps, place geocaches and locate diseased trees.
BI-03	Replacement First Aid Kits (5) \$130		Update kits in park vehicles and office.
BI-04	Truck Mounted Snowplow \$2,600		A plow is needed to maintain access to the campground and fossil house during the winter.

BI-05	45 star US Flag \$40 Requires replacement every 2 years.		The Berlin Ranger Station flies this flag to commemorate Berlin's heyday in the late 1800's.
BI-06	Supplies for Diana Mine		Safety equipment such as O₂ sensors and headlamps. Lumber and labor for repairs.

CL-01	10' x 5' Utility Trailer \$1,500		Great for hauling logs, ATV's, and building materials.

EASTERN NEVADA STATE PARKS REGIONAL VISITOR CENTER

Item No.	Price Range		Description
EN-01	Computer Desks/Chairs \$160		Ergonomic desks and chairs are needed to prevent injuries to wrists, arms and backs.
EN-02	20" Flat Screen Computer Monitor \$120		Replacement of old monitors with new monitors with better resolution to prevent eye strain.
EN-03	Laptop Computer for Interpretative presentations \$2,000		Having a laptop for presentations will enable the park interpreter to design Power Point presentation, videos and simulations that enhance the visitor experience.
EN-04	Wireless Router \$150		Due to the inability of running hidden wires in the visitor center we need a secured wireless router to connect our computers.
EN-05	UPS Surge Protector/battery backup \$90		In rural Nevada power is questionable and with lighting storms and power surges it is imperative that we protect our electronic equipment—especially if we get new computers and monitors.

EN-06	Slide converter \$100		There are thousands of slides of the region that could be used if they were converted into a digital format.
EN-07	High Resolution Digital Camera \$600		This is needed to record our interpretative events and interpretative talks. All five Eastern Nevada State Parks are currently sharing one camera.
EN-08	Adobe Creative Suite 5 Design Premium \$2,000		Having a powerful media suite will allow staff to create visual and interactive presentations which enhance the visitor experience through better interpretative methods.
EN-09	Vacuum Cleaner \$400		Needed to keep the visitor center clean.
EN-10	Carpet Cleaner \$400		Needed to keep the visitor center clean.
EN-11	GPS \$500		Since we have entered the world of Geocaching it is imperative that we have the correct equipment. Not to mention, these are a great tool to update our trails maps and conduct resource inventories.

EN-12	60" LCD Monitor with DVD player, surround sound, and mounting bracket \$2,700		An LCD panel will allow staff to utilize the Interpretative Center for more than just a short DVD. Adding modern equipment expands opportunities to provide more engaging presentations, enhancing the visitor experience.
EN-13	Media center for LCD		Required to protect the LCD panel, DVD, and house the speakers and includes shelving and cases to display interpretative items and artifacts.
EN-14	Interpretative Displays		To increase the functionality of the auditorium and turn it into an Interpretative Center, interpretative displays are needed, including adding a shadow box to the back of the room to house our Bison bones and the Echo Canyon pot
EN-15	Heating and Air-conditioning in the Interpretative Center.		Currently, there is no duct work in the auditorium which means no heating or air-conditioning. In the summer it is sweltering and in the winter freezing. Visitors cannot sit in there to watch the movie, let alone any other presentation.
EN-16	15" Digital Frame \$150		This frame would be used to display photos of each of the parks in our area. They could be changed for seasonal and event displays to add interest and variety to the Visitor Center.

EN-17	Remodel of the Visitor Center to bring it into the 21 st Century including:	This building has not had any updates or changes in almost 15 years. It is a unique building, but is in dire need of improvements to attract visitors and allow the public to see what is available in the region.
EN-18	ADA Accessible Door Openers	Needed to be ADA compliant.
EN-18a	New Paint	New paint for the information and gift area to create the illusion that you are standing inside one of the slot canyon spires.
EN-18b	New Counters	New counters for the information and gift area to create a less intrusive design and have more space for interpretive or informational displays.
EN-18c	Track Lighting	New track lighting that is smaller, cooler and more energy efficient to cut cooling costs in the summer and electrical costs all year-round.
EN-18d	Moulding	Molding for the information and gift area around the tile floor needs to be replaced.

EN-18e	Front office upgrades	The television in the storage closet needs to be removed and replaced with and LCD TV that should be mounted in a media center in the Interpretation Center. Specialized shelving in the closet needs to be built to house interpretative supplies and equipment. A new carpet to tile threshold is also needed.
EN-18f	Back office upgrades	Replacement of the carpet will provide a more professional appearance to the area and a new counter with built-in shelving is needed to store brochures, equipment, and other materials.
EN-18g	Grounds	New lighting outside the building that works; both on the building and lighting the pathway.
EN-18h	Landscaping	Landscaping outside the Visitor Center and around the parking lot area. Landscaping should be Xeriscaping to mimic the desert environment and habitat and to save water.
EN-18i	Sealcoat	Sealcoat parking lot. This needs to done to extend the life of the blacktop which is starting to deteriorate.

EN-18j	Directional signage \$500	Directional signs for the Visitor Center including a kiosk with a map.
EN-19	Moveable park bench and or chairs \$400	 <p>Many guests would appreciate having a place to sit and enjoy the area and watch the birds in an outside setting. These seats should be moveable and weatherproof to take advantage of the changing seasons and sunshine.</p>
EN-20	Interpretive signs at the Visitor Center and Beaver Dam sign	There are few signs in the park that describe what the visitors are viewing. The Beaver Dam sign outside the Visitor Center needs to be replaced as it is written about Schroeder Reservoir.
EN-21	Cathedral Gorge and Miller Point signs on Hwy 93	Both signs are too small for people traveling at 70 mph on the highway. It would benefit everyone to have better signs advertising the park and its accommodations for the public enjoyment.

WL-03	Portable Restrooms \$700		Help keep park operations costs down by helping us to purchase portable restrooms instead of renting. These units are needed for winter when flush facilities are closed.
