## Partial campground closure at Wild Horse State Recreation Area due to construction

ELKO, Nev. – Campground improvements at Wild Horse State Recreation Area will begin on Monday, October 7, and continue through November 17. In order to complete these improvements, partial closure of the campground will be necessary. The shower and dump station facilities will remain available, but campsites within the park will be limited.

A large scope of the work includes the creation of more pull through sites and shade structures at each site. There is still an abundance of camping available outside the state park. Nevada State Parks would like to thank all of its users for their patience through the construction process.
