

HORSEBACK RIDING POLICY VALLEY OF FIRE STATE PARK

Horse trailer parking is only permitted at R.O. Road (gravel road on the north side of Valley of Fire Road, between Scenic Loop and the visitor center – indicated by a “Road Closed” sign) and on the dirt road on the south side of Valley of Fire Road across from the Cabins turnoff. At these parking areas, vehicles with horse trailers can be parked and unloaded, and riding can commence.

At R.O. Road, riders can only head north into the park on Prospect Trail and northwest on the Pinnacles Loop Trail.

At the Cabins turnoff parking area, visitors can ride in the wash to the west and southeast, and for access to Arrowhead and Charlie’s Spring Trails.

Horses are also permitted in Logandale Trails (the northern section of Valley of Fire State Park and adjoining Bureau of Land Management property). These trails can be reached via Liston Road in Logandale, Nevada. Please note that this area is frequently used as off-road access for ATVs, OHVs, and dirt bikes.

Horseback riding is NOT allowed in campgrounds, in or around picnic areas, on park roads, or any other park trails.
