

NEVADA DIVISION OF STATE PARKS
“CLASS A” PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING REGULATIONS
(This form must be read, signed and dated, and sent in with the application.)

1. Only Class A (1-3 vehicles, 2-15 persons) photography/filming is allowed on weekends and holidays.
 2. **NO** nude photography/filming is allowed anywhere in the park.
 3. Permittee shall not block public access within the park (entrance stations, hiking trails, visitor center, etc.).
 4. **NO** photography/filming is allowed near or on Elephant Rock or Arch Rock.
 5. Off-road driving or parking is strictly prohibited. On-site representatives will be fined, and the permit may be revoked for violations of this regulation. **NO** off-road activity will take place without prior approval of the Division.
 6. All paperwork and site location(s) must be approved before shooting starts.
 7. **Absolutely all garbage generated by photography/film crews must be hauled away by the photography/film crew.** If a dumpster is to be delivered to the park, a copy of the agreement must be provided from Republic Services for proof of the correct billing address.
 8. Nevada law protects all plants, animals, rocks and mineral materials within the park. Do **NOT** remove or disturb any plants, animals, rocks, petrified wood or other natural resource.
 9. Permittee is responsible for leaving the area in the condition in which they found it and should be free of all litter (including candy wrappers, cigarette butts, fruit peels, etc.).
 10. Any photography/filming on roadways will require traffic control. Requirements include:
 - Police on both sides of the controlled area; the Division may provide this service at current billable rates.
 - Public access, with a wait of no longer than five minutes.
 - Roadways free of unnecessary vehicles, as roads are not to be used for parking.
 - Traffic closures are limited to 1-mile increments and 5-minute hold time.
 - Traffic control vehicles are counted toward vehicle total allowed by the permit.
 - No “rolling roadblocks” or “moving ITC.”
 11. Park hours are sunrise to sunset. Early set-up and/or late departures require advance approval.
 12. If any props or equipment are left in the park overnight, security must be provided by the photography/film crew.
 13. Any removal of signs, road markers, or road lines must have prior approval by the Division. Failure to obtain Division approval will result in the imposition of fines and possible revocation of the permit.
 14. The speed limit is 35mph on Valley of Fire Highway and 25mph on all other roads. Speed limits are strictly enforced.
 15. Park phones, copy machine, etc. are not available for use by Permittee.
 16. Park staff does not take any messages for Permittee, except in the case of a true emergency.
 17. **DRONES:** FAA Section 333 exemption, or a Part 107 certificate, is required to be in possession of the pilot. Having an application in progress for Section 333 is not valid.
 18. **NO** photography/filming is allowed in designated wedding locations: the Visitor Center and Seven Sisters.

19. No parking on sides of the roadway due to soft shoulders. Use parking lots and/or approved parking areas only.
 20. To allow for emergency access, no parking is allowed in front of any gates.
 21. Restrictions apply to the use of heavy equipment. Please consult with park staff regarding applicable restrictions.
